

### **Asserted Rights of Way**

Asserted Rights of Way are those routes which have been identified as public Rights of Way, formally approved at Council and recorded as such in accordance with the Access to the Countryside Order (Northern Ireland) 1983.

- Andrew's Shorefield to North Down Coastal Path, Groomsport
- King John's walk, Creighton's Green Road, Holywood
- Williamson's Lane, Gransha, Bangor
- Demesne Grove to Plas Merdyn, Holywood
- Crawfordsburn Road to Country Park
- Rowallane Close to Rowan Glen, Bangor
- Bryansglen Park to NDCP
- The Quarries, Gransha Road to Ballycrochan Road
- NDCP Glen Road to Station Road
- Torgrange, Bangor Road to Carlston Avenue, Holywood

### **Alleged Rights of Way**

NDBC also hold a register of all those routes which have been brought to their attention over the years and alleged as Public Rights of Way. However, these routes have not yet been formally asserted at Council. The following routes within Bangor West, are held on record as 'alleged' Public Rights of Way:

- Golf Road to NDCP, Helen's Bay
- Cattle Drive, Craigdarragh Road to Quarry Court and Railway Bridge (currently being considered for assertion),
- Helen's Bay· Coyles Lane to Ballyrobert Village
- Kathleen Avenue to Rushfield, Helen's Bay
- Sheridan Drive to NDCP, Helen's Bay
- Clandeboye Way
- Killaire Road to NDCP, Bangor
- Martello Park to Bangor Road, Seahill
- Meadow Way to Dual Carriageway, Crawfordsburn
- Main Street Crawfordsburn to Crawfordsburn River
- Crawfordsburn Country Park to NDCP
